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SUMMER CAMP



Overview

Which one is right for my child?

In a national survey, camp directors reported that parents rate the most important benefits of camp to be increased **self confidence and self esteem**, a **safe place** for kids to spend their time, a great way for them to make **new friends** and a bonus- camps provide **fun activities!**

Make plans now to send your child to camp this summer. This overview of the types of camps available will help you get a jump start on your planning!

RESIDENT CAMPS

Resident Camps are designed for campers staying at camp from several days to one or more weeks. Campers sleep overnight in cabins, tents or other forms of shelter, and participate in a variety of supervised activities. Most resident camps offer a general program of outdoor activities including hiking, swimming, sports and games, plus arts and crafts and nature awareness. Camp counselors are on hand to help kids fit in and get them past any homesickness they may experience.

DAY CAMPS

Day Camps offer a wide variety of activities as well, with one main difference...the campers get to go home at the end of each day. Day camps are available in half-day and full-day programs, and regularly include field trips to local museums, parks and other recreational places. Day camps can be a great way to prepare younger kids for future summers at a resident camp.

SPECIAL INTEREST CAMPS

Do your kids aspire to be an Olympic gymnast? A marine biologist? Or maybe a Drama Queen? Special Interest Camps provide focus on specific activities, such as gymnastics, music, computers, sports, drama and more. These camps are usually day camps, but some are offered as an over-night or resident camp.

FAMILY CAMPS

Great for building fun family memories, these camps are usually located in wooded areas, may offer lake activities, and fun in the great outdoors. Since families usually eat in large dining halls, no need to worry about meal planning on this vacation. Many families use this option as a chance to coordinate vacation times with other family friends or relatives.

Whichever camp you choose, you can be assured your children will benefit from the experience and have a lot of fun, too! Make sure and check out this issue for a list of camps you will definitely want to check out.

There are plenty of hot spots around town to enjoy a cool tasty treat or you can DIY your own ice cream at home! Here's a recipe for DIY Ice Cream in a Baggie!
Ingredients

1/4 cup milk

1/4 cup half-and-half

1 tablespoon white sugar

1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 cup ice cubes, or as needed

3 tablespoons ice cream rock salt

Optional: chocolate or strawberry syrup, sprinkles or other toppings

Directions

Pour sugar, milk, half-and-half and vanilla extract in a pint-size zipper bag; seal bag tightly, squish the ingredients to blend together. (additional option to add a squirt of strawberry or chocolate syrup in this step)

In a gallon-size zipper bag put a scoop of ice, 3 tablespoons rock salt, and the pint-size bag with the milk mixture; seal tightly.

Shake it, dance with it, toss it, jump up and down with it for about 10 minutes until set.

Remove small bag and wipe salt water off with clean towel before opening. Squeeze into a bowl and add desired toppings! Enjoy!

10. Get Wet!

Jump in a pool, spend a day at the beach, or play in the splash pad at the Kemah Boardwalk.

Parenting is serious business and it can be overwhelming at times. It can also be a whole lot of fun if you find ways to sneak some play in your day. You don't have to shirk grown-up responsibilities or make a fool of yourself (not that there's anything wrong with that) to become a more playful parent.

Here are some easy-peasy ways to have more fun with your kids. Why not try one today? You can clean out the fridge tomorrow.

Answer the call of nature. The demands of adult life can be hard to ignore. Bills are piled up on your desk and dinner isn't on the table yet. Ditch the distractions by going outside. Walk or bicycle around the neighborhood or help your kids build a fort, sandcastle, or snowman. Outdoor playtime is especially energizing.

Work it out. A game of catch, tag or capture the flag can substitute for your usual workout if you let yourself get sweaty. Sports help kids develop muscle strength, coordination and control. They also burn off extra energy before bedtime. That means everyone gets to rest easier.

Take a role. Is your child begging you to join him in fantasy land? Enact your assigned role with gusto. Adopt an appropriate voice and use outlandish gestures to define your character. Stay in the role even if your child starts to slip back into reality – this is guaranteed to give kids the giggles. And nothing is quite as contagious as a good belly laugh.

Teach grown-up games. If children's games can't hold your interest for more than a minute, it's time to up the ante. Teach kids the basic rules of adult games, like checkers, blackjack or Yahtzee. Keep score for both yourself and your child if she isn't old enough to do the math. Grown-up games can be fun (and educational) for everyone.

Bend the rules. Kids often enjoy making up their own rules to games. Let them have

at it. Follow their instructions in the spirit of playfulness instead of harping on the "real rules" of the game. Play is supposed to be creative and expansive, not stodgy and confining.

Change up the usual routine. Serve breakfast for dinner or have a pizza picnic on the living room floor. Pitch a tent in the backyard and camp out overnight as a family. Wear silly socks or turn your sweatshirt inside out. Everyday activities like eating and sleeping can be playful if you get creative.

Shift your speed. Are you feeling impatient or stressed out by the pace of family life? Laugh it off by talking and moving in fast-forward or super slow-motion. Kids can't help noticing you are doing something different when you change your pace. A little levity opens the pressure-relief valve so you can cope more effectively.

Make faces. Your mother may have warned you that your face would freeze in a scowl if you didn't change your expression. But you know that's not true. Have a contest with the kids to see who can make the goofiest facial expression. Take pics with your smart phone and post them to Facebook so friends can vote on the winner. Who needs dignity when you have bragging rights?

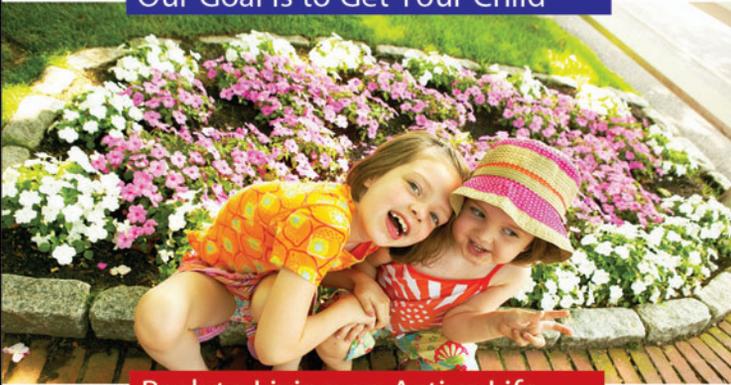
